

Art and Design The aim of our Art and Design curriculum is to explore ideas, produce creative work and record experiences. We show pupils how to evaluate and analyse creative ideas and understand where to make improvements to help develop their work further. In line with the National Curriculum, pupils are offered a diverse course which is designed to engage, inspire and challenge, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art, craft and design. As pupils progress, they are encouraged to think critically and develop a more rigorous understanding of art and design. They are taught to think about their own lines of creative enquiry. During this time pupils will be given the opportunity to develop skills and become proficient in drawing, painting, sculpture, photography, animation and other art, craft and design techniques. Pupils keep a working sketchbook and produce a portfolio of work which is then assessed towards AQA Unit Awards.
