

KS3 English work – description

Imagine standing outside as snow is falling. Think back to the last time it snowed. Can you remember how it felt? How does snow make you feel?



Simile

- Using **like/as** to compare one thing to another.
- **The man was as tall as a skyscraper.**
- **She moved like a snail!**

Create three similes from your picture.

E.g. The sky is as blue as a blueberry.
The zebras stood like statues.

Personification

- This is a type of metaphor, where something **non-human** is described in a **human way**.
- **The wind whistled past his face.**
- **The trees danced in the breeze.**

Come up with three examples of personification from your picture.

Can you write 3 similes and 3 examples of personification about this picture?

Now, try to write at least one paragraph describing the snowy scene. Try to include similes and personification and use all five senses. What can you see, hear, smell, taste, feel? I have also included some other words for 'white' to help you!
