

## KS3 Maths

Mathematics at Key Stage 3 equips the pupils with a sound knowledge, understanding and skills they require to ensure they are able to achieve their full potential at GCSE.

Independent learning is actively encouraged and every opportunity for using mathematics in practical tasks, in real life problems and investigations within mathematics are sought.

We follow the National Curriculum programme of study incorporating the topics Number, Algebra, Geometry and Data Handling.

Every pupil is baseline tested when starting at the PRS. This then informs the teachers planning of lessons, making sure each lesson is personalised for the pupil, helping them to achieve their full potential. Pupils are then regularly assessed throughout the year to measure progress and monitor targets.

The Key Stage 3 Mathematics classroom is fully equipped to help pupils make progress, with displays full of pupils work, keywords displayed, the process of how to learn a new skill displayed. Each pupil has access to scientific calculators, laptops, an interactive whiteboard and all mathematical equipment.
