

Primary Provision

This is a very new provision. We follow the Primary National Curriculum which provides pupils with an introduction to the essential knowledge that they need to be educated citizens. We teach each subject through a theme at Key Stage 1 and 2. The themes are weather, superheroes and the seaside. Exciting and stimulating lessons are planned to develop pupils knowledge, understanding and skills. The unit is fully resourced with a variety of fact, fiction and poetry books for each theme and to encourage the enjoyment of reading.

Embedded in the curriculum is the 6 principles of nurture. These are ; children's learning is understood developmentally, the classroom offers a safe place, the importance of nurture for the development of wellbeing, language is a vital means of communication, all behaviour is communication. These are visited using every opportunity throughout the school day by how we communicate with each other, work together, taking turns and they inform our planning for each subject. We Boxall Profile each child when they come to us which enable us to set individual behaviour targets and monitor progress of these.
