

Tutor Time

Point made by Pupils	Reactions from PRU
Hot drinks to be available	Hot drinks are available in the kitchen at breakfast time (8.20-9am) Health and Safety dictates hot drinks are not safe to be carried around the school by pupils.
Longer breakfast time	Breakfast time is already 40 minutes. If pupils are late to school through no fault of their own eg taxi then they will be allowed to have breakfast and a drink before going to Tutor Time or lesson.
Don't like reading	<p>As a school we are trying to encourage everyone including staff to read more. This doesn't have to be a book it can be an article or a magazine or newspaper.</p> <p>Some people have expressed that they want to have a class book, this can be arranged, speak to your tutor.</p>
Chill out during Tutor Time/ A catch up time	Tutor Time can be a chill out time, it is an opportunity to prepare for the day. Reading or the booklets can be altered to different days. It is also an opportunity to have a catch up with your tutor about anything you have going on. Please understand though that there are others in the group so you may need to request to speak to your tutor alone at some point – this isn't a problem though.
Breakfast Snacks	Snacks can be ordered such as bars etc.
Food in Tutor Room	This isn't allowed, there is plenty of time to eat in the kitchen see Longer Breakfast Time.

Catch Up doesn't work	If pupils feel this way how can we change it, what will work as the behaviour policy works around the point system and the sanction for low points is 'Catch Up' or Period 7.
Point system is a good way to help pupils cope throughout the day	As above
Time Out card a good idea	This does work well for some pupils, if a pupil feels they need a Time Out card, please speak to Mr Moore or Mrs Fox
Earn a day off or non-uniform through points.	We would not be able to allow time off however as stated earlier non uniform would be available to those on High Pass
Pupils asked how much was in their school bank account	Tutors are able to access this information, pupils should ask during Tutor Time.
